Commentary

Eighteen wards are ranked as being in the top 10% most deprived in the country on the 'distance to shop' indicator. The wards are all within the districts of Rother, Wealden, Lewes and Chichester. The most deprived ward on this measure is Ewhurst and Sedlescombe in Rother which ranks 78th nationally.
